The staff of Georgia Public Library Service is pleased to present the 2015 edition of "A Current Look at Georgia's Public Libraries," offering a detailed examination of the operations, funding and usage of the 404 public libraries throughout our state. Our goal is that this report will showcase the value of public library service to all Georgians.

This report documents the fiscal year that ended June 30, 2014. Its data is drawn from the annual reports submitted to our office by each library system. This aggregate data is submitted to the federal Institute of Museum and Library Services to help provide a national picture of public library service.

A Current Look provides timely, detailed data in ways that we hope are useful to those who fund, support and use the public libraries in Georgia. This year's data shows a continuing growth in demand and use of electronic and digital services, while the use of traditional library materials remains strong and consistent. It is gratifying to note that Georgians of all ages continue to enjoy library programs and services, from traditional story times to innovative electronic and downloadable resources. Public libraries are a trusted and valued resource throughout Georgia.

Public libraries remain essential at every level of education throughout the state. They deliver valuable support for children and parents by providing preschool and preliteracy programs, as well as resources for K-12 and higher education. With high-speed broadband connections, Wi-Fi access and, in many cases, cost-saving cloud-based public-access computers, public libraries prove daily that they are resource centers providing limitless opportunities for education and innovation. Libraries also deliver increasingly important services needed by adults pursuing new career paths and who need convenient access to online services from local, state and federal government agencies. Our public libraries are being recognized as statewide leaders in technology and educational support, as strong contributors to localized workforce development, and as civic and cultural hubs in Georgia communities large and small.

We hope this report demonstrates the value of public libraries to community leaders, trustees, administrators, and those esteemed funders at the state and local level whose support makes the services we deliver to each community possible. Your commitment to maintaining excellence in library service throughout Georgia is evident and appreciated.

Georgia's Library Laws

- GPLS is the state library administrative agency for Georgia and gives aid, counsel and advice to all public libraries in Georgia and works in a limited supervisory capacity with the 63 public library systems.
- O.C.G.A. § 20-5-2 (a) states that the agency "... shall give aid, advice and counsel to all libraries."
- O.C.G.A. § 20-5-2 (a) states that the agency "... shall exercise supervision over all public libraries and endeavor to improve libraries already established."
- O.C.G.A. § 20-5-302 (a) states that the agency "... shall annually determine and request of the General Assembly the amount of funds needed for county and regional public libraries."
- O.C.G.A. § 20-5-302 (a) states "Public Library funds shall be apportioned to county and regional public libraries in proportion to the area and population to be served by such libraries ..."
- Public library systems in Georgia are either single-county or multiple-county, based on the individual participating agreements.
 There are currently 34 multiple-county (regional) public library systems and 29 single-county public library systems. O.C.G.A.
 § 20-5-41 places authority of single-county library systems with the county board of trustees and places authority of multiple-county library systems with the regional board of trustees.
- While GPLS strongly supports efficiency and economy in the operation of public library systems, it realizes that local
 preferences, history and political realities drive the decisions of how public libraries are configured and aligned. It is the role of
 GPLS to advocate for strong, fiscally sound and viable public libraries.

Expenditures and Staffing of GPLS – Fiscal Year 2014

- In FY14, total state funding for Georgia Public Library Service was approximately \$31.5 million, 78.53% of which was distributed directly to public libraries under the grants program.
- Georgia Public Library Service used 17.2% of its budget for agency operations and on-behalf services to libraries, including the costs of coordinating the statewide public library initiatives of PINES, GALILEO and Internet services.
- A total of 44 positions are allocated for the Georgia Public Library Service. 41 of these positions are currently filled.
 - o GLASS 12 FTE
 - o PINES and IT 16 FTE
 - Library Development 5 FTE
 - o Administration and Business Services 11 FTE

GPLS - Recent Benchmarks and Milestones

PINES

- Circulated 16,637,412 items in FY14.
- More than 2.3 million PINES library cards in use during FY14.
- Extended and continues to maintain the PINES integrated library computer system in 53 public library systems.
- Contracted with a courier (book delivery) service among all public library system's central facilities and University System of Georgia (USG) academic libraries.
- Continued to participate in the wider Evergreen community by mentoring new Evergreen libraries and by continuing cooperative software development efforts.
- Continued to facilitate resource sharing, with intra-PINES loans increasing to 664,654.
- Provided quarterly scheduled training and customized on-demand sessions for the PINES member library systems.

General Public Library Support

- Continued to work with libraries and local funding agencies to maintain excellence in services through challenging economic times.
- Provided continuing support to Friends of Georgia Libraries.
- Continued to provide training for library staff and trustees through both instructor-led training on demand and through scholarships to training offered by outside vendors.

- Provided consultant to assist public library systems with local strategic planning.
- Continued to administer and utilize funds provided by the federal Library Services and Technology Act toward the improvement and enhancement of library services in Georgia.
- Continued to publish public library statistics for public information and use in advocacy for local public libraries.

Youth Services

- In FY14, helped public libraries strengthen local partnerships with agencies, institutions, businesses, and groups by coordinating PRIME TIME efforts in 11 library systems (Athens Regional Library System, Atlanta-Fulton Public Library System, Coastal Plain Regional Library System, DeKalb County Public Library, Fitzgerald-Ben Hill County Library System, Gwinnett County Public Library, Marshes of Glynn Libraries, Roddenbery Memorial Library, Three Rivers Regional Library System).
- 3,752 children and caregivers attended these PRIME TIME programs in FY14.
- Hosted "Clifford's Tour de Georgia" featuring Clifford the Big Red Dog. Clifford visited 13 programs hosted by Georgia public libraries.
- In FY14, Georgia's statewide Summer Reading Program enjoyed attendance of 485,209.
- Partnered with other agencies such as the Georgia Humanities Council, Georgia Public Broadcasting, and the Path2College 529 College Savings Plan to help strengthen Georgia libraries' youth services programs.

Services for the Blind and Others Requiring Books and Magazines in Audio Formats or in Braille

- Provided library services for the blind and others whose physical abilities require the use of books and magazines in audio format or in braille, through a network of libraries and a central distribution center.
- Provided talking book and braille materials to 16,309 registered users across Georgia in FY14.
- Circulated (mailed) 377,246 items to eligible enrolled readers in Georgia.
- Provided access to digital titles that were downloaded 108,694 times in FY14.
- Promoted emphasis on outreach and patron services at the local level.
- Realigned network of outreach centers and sub-regional libraries to better serve individuals and institutions in all counties in Georgia.
- Continued to assist readers with the transition from audio cassette to digital book and magazine collections.
- Reallocated space in the GLASS Distribution Center to better reflect the requirements of an increasingly digital collection.

Strategic Partnerships

 Georgia Public Library Service partners with a number of state and private organizations to provide an additional layer of support and awareness for the state's public libraries These partnership programs have educated and entertained thousands of Georgia residents while saving more than \$10 million in direct expenditures and

- providing hundreds of hours of free programming for public libraries over the life of the program.
- Strategic partnership programs were renewed with Georgia State Parks & Historic Sites, the Atlanta Braves, the Atlanta Hawks, Zoo Atlanta, the Center for Puppetry Arts, the Georgia Center for the Book, Georgia's Path2College 529 Plan, the Go Fish Education Center, Georgia Council for the Arts, Georgia Environmental Finance Authority, and VSA Arts of Georgia's Arts for All Gallery.
- Public library system websites hosted by GPLS experienced a 141% increase in traffic between 2013 and 2014, reaching a total of 2,851,580 individual visits. The number of hits on those websites' pages topped 111 million up 3% from 2013. GPLS also saw social media interest in public libraries increase between 2013 and 2014, with Facebook followers increasing by 43 percent and Twitter followers by 69 percent.

Technology-Based Support

- Provided assistance and training for E-rate program.
- Provided maintenance and support for servers hosting centralized email and SPAM filtering for 47 libraries without local capability.
- Provided technical support, maintenance, and website hosting for 31 library systems.
- In FY14, hosted a Technology Boot Camp an initiative of the Georgia Public Library Service to bring together IT professionals from our libraries to share experiences and ideas and to explore opportunities made possible by emerging technologies, resulting in a clearinghouse of current IT trends and practices: http://galibtech.org/.

- Provision of a help desk for library technology responded to and closed over 500 staff-initiated IT inquiries.
- Hosted cloud-based public access computers for the majority of Georgia public libraries, increasing the numbers of public access computers by 47% in 2013-2014.

Continuing Education and Training

- In FY14, GPLS hosted 52 live continuing education and training events for library staff, accounting for 181 hours of instruction and reaching 1,364 staff members.
- Administered Georgia Library Education Network (GLEAN) access for over 2,500 public, school and academic library employees.
- Provided 5,000+ on-demand e-learning courses through GLEAN to a diverse audience of eligible employees.
- Collaborated with other state library agencies to provide Georgia libraries with monthly, comprehensive listings of

- free webinars covering a range of industry-related competencies and subject areas.
- Promoted flexible training and continuing education programs in individual library systems by providing public libraries free access to WebEx Enterprise Edition.

Resource Sharing

- Administered the reciprocal borrowing and lending activity of more than 200 GOLD multi-type member libraries resulting in lending 158,344 items and borrowing 126,896 through interlibrary loans during FY14.
- Purchased group access to OCLC Services for all public libraries including a group catalog.
- Paid GALILEO resource fees for all 63 public library systems to provide patron access to the statewide virtual library.
- Continued to support Georgia HomePLACE as a component of the Digital Library of Georgia.

Return on Investment

The value of public libraries' services to the people of Georgia


- 39,001,826 books and other materials were borrowed from Georgia's public libraries in FY14.
 - o The average book costs \$25.00.
 - o This saved the people of Georgia a total of \$975,045,650.
- 1,580,050 children and young adults attended programs at Georgia's public libraries in FY14.
 - o The average cost of a movie theater ticket was \$9.50. (http://www.fandango.com/)
 - o This was equivalent to Georgia parents spending \$15,010,475.
- 13,224,365 public-access Internet computer sessions were used at Georgia's public libraries in FY14.
 - o The average cost of a computer workstation rental with Internet access at a cybercafé (http://www.cybercafes.com) and similar business centers is an average of \$7 per hour session.
 - o This saved the people of Georgia a total of \$92,570,555.

The value of **just** these three public library services was **\$1,082,626,680** (\$104.65 per capita) in FY14. Total Georgia public libraries operating expenditures were only **\$182,981,053** (\$17.69 per capita) in FY14.

Return on investment = \$5.92 to \$1.00

State Funding for Georgia's Public Libraries

- By state law OCGA § 20-5-3, state funding is apportioned by formula to the library systems on the basis of population and geography (http://www.georgialibraries.org/lib/library_laws/).
- State funding is provided for professional salaries, library materials, operational support, libraries for the blind and physically handicapped, and, by grant award, for capital improvement.
- Georgia is the only state that provides grants that are specifically designated for the salaries of professional librarians, thus
 ensuring that each system is administered and led by graduate librarians.
- 16% of funding for public libraries in Georgia came from the state.
- In FY14, the per capita revenue from state government was \$2.38. The national average per capita for FY12 was \$2.60.





Local Funding for Georgia's Public Libraries

- Local funding (including one-time and capital funding) for Georgia's public libraries varied widely across the state in FY14, ranging from \$4.82 to \$34.36. Local funding in FY13 ranged from \$4.21 to \$38.64 per capita.
- The majority of the public library systems in Georgia received local funding that was below the statewide average of \$12.93.
- Local funding for all but two (Forsyth County Public Library and Chattahoochee Valley Regional Libraries) of the 63 Georgia library systems was below the national average FY12 of \$30.74.
- Three public library systems (Brooks County Public Library, Hart County Library System, and Ocmulgee Regional Library System) received less local funding than state funding.
- 81.8% of funding for public libraries in Georgia came from local sources.




Library Cards and Circulation in FY 2014

- 4,164,735 individuals held public library cards in FY14. The latest Georgia QuickFacts from the U.S. Census reported a total of 3,518,097 Georgia households; an average of 1.19 registered public library patrons per Georgia household.
- Over 43% of all Georgians are registered public library patrons.
- Library systems that participate in Georgia Public Library Service's PINES automation and lending network counted 2,302,968
 active PINES library cards as of June 30, 2014.
- More than half of all registered public library patrons in Georgia live in a county that is part of a library system that participates in PINES.
- Georgia libraries circulated 39 million library items or 3.77 items per capita in FY14. The national average (FY12) for circulation per capita was 8.0.



Public-Access Computers in Georgia's Public Libraries

- Public library Internet computers were used over 13 million times in FY14.
- There were 8,492 public computer workstations with high-speed Internet access in Georgia public libraries at the close of FY14.
- The national average (FY11) for public-access computers per 5,000 people was 4.4. Georgia's average in FY14 was 4.1 public-access computers per 5,000 people.
- Coordinated by GPLS in Georgia, the federal E-rate program the national Universal Service Discount Program for Schools and Libraries provides almost 78% of the funds for Georgia's statewide public library data network.
- All public-access Internet computers have access to GALILEO databases.
- GALILEO databases searches numbered 4.7 million through public library access in FY14.
- Three hundred seventy-four library facilities (92.6%) provide wireless services for library users.


Resource Sharing – Interlibrary Loans and Courier Service

- Public libraries provide lending services to their cardholders. These are defined as circulations. Each item of library material
 going out of the library is considered a circulation. Another type of circulation, which requires at least three times the manual
 processes of a circulation, is interlibrary loan. This is a service whereby a user of one library can borrow books that are owned by
 another library. The user makes a request with their local library, which, acting as an intermediary, identifies owners of the
 desired item, places the request, receives the item, makes it available to the user, and arranges for its return.
- Through Georgia Online Database (GOLD), GPLS coordinates the interlibrary loaning of books and other materials between libraries of all types including academic, public, technical schools and special libraries. Over 200 institutions loaned and borrowed almost 50,000 items from each other in 2014.
- Interlibrary loan requires the librarian to receive the request, pull the book from the shelves, check it out of the online library catalog, and prepare a mailing package or a PINES courier package to send the item to the requesting library. This work is overlooked when using only circulation as a statistic for workload of the library staff, but it accounted for 822,998 items sent to other library systems.
- Georgia's public libraries made **815,477** interlibrary loans to patrons in Fiscal Year 2014.
- Of these loans, 664,654 were processed through the Georgia Library PINES network.
- The contracted state-supported library courier service transported **1,512,588** library materials in FY 2014, visiting every headquarter library five (5) days per week. This includes loans and items returned at libraries other than the owning/circulating library.


Collections Owned by Georgia's Public Libraries

Library Materials by Category FY 2014



Expenditures of Georgia's Public Libraries


Per Capita Expenditures for Staff in Georgia Public Libraries

- The majority (43) of Georgia public library systems spent less than the state average per capita of \$12.56 for staff.


Total Public Library Expenditures
